

The Impingtones Covid-19 Information Sheet

This information sheet details the measures we are obliged to take for choir sessions to go ahead. The Impingtones has a responsibility to keep ourselves and others as safe as possible and we have undertaken risk assessments in relation to Covid-19 (see [COVID Risk Assessment](#)). Our new larger venue allows us to spread out and the large doors provide good ventilation. Posters will be positioned at the doors to remind members that they should not be taking part in choir if they feel unwell at all. Please respect this.

We are certain you will all understand the need for these measures. Whilst it is not possible to eliminate all transmission risks, our actions can reduce the risks. It is for each individual to decide whether to attend, depending on their own personal circumstances and health.

Please do not come to choir if:

- you feel unwell (including headache, runny nose, etc, see [Symptoms for Covid-19](#)).
- you have tested positive (lateral flow, PCR or other).
- someone you have close contact with has tested positive.
- you have been told to self-isolate.
- you need to quarantine after a trip abroad.

What actions will we all need to take at choir sessions?

- If it becomes necessary to queue outside, please do so at a distance from others.
- We prefer members to wear a face covering when entering/leaving the building unless you are [exempt](#). Face coverings can be removed when you are seated.
- Keep at least a 2m distance from other choir members.
- Remain in your seat unless directed otherwise. We will leave at the end of the session, row by row.
- Everyone will be provided with a music pack, avoiding the need to share music.
- When entering and leaving the building, social distancing should be maintained.

What if someone tests positive for Covid-19 after attending a choir session?

- If you test positive for Covid-19 (lateral flow, PCR or other) and have attended choir, please inform the Committee urgently: 07780 815841 or impingtones@gmail.com.
- Accurate records of attendance will be kept including the seating positions of individual members.
- We will inform every person in attendance at the choir session via email if a member who attended has subsequently tested positive.
- We will pass relevant contact details to NHS Test & Trace if requested by them.
